// <p>The first week of owning our 2018 Mojito Jeep Wrangler Unlimited Rubicon was started off with some quick and easy upgrades. ♦ We added a set of Mopar All Weather Floor Mats, a Hitch Extension from Toweever for my bike rack to clear the spare tire, and a Shorty Antenna.
